A Laboratory for Ideas and Action

The Chair of Innovation Management & Healthcare Performance pursues two objectives: 1/ train the upcoming generation of medical doctors to manage health innovations and sponsor projects in an entrepreneurial spirit; 2/ conduct research in industrial economics and value-based healthcare, in particular by measuring outcomes that matter to patients.

An Action-Learning Approach

In partnership with Amgen & Medtronic, the Chair develops an action-learning approach based on real-world case studies, role playing and negotiation workshops co-facilitated by the decision-makers actually involved in the case studies. Team projects are conducted in tandem with Chair partners. The Chair also organizes immersion visits to world-class medical sites. Chair sessions focus on fostering leadership and decision-making skills, promoting team spirit, and providing international exposure.

Research Activities

The Chair has produced publications in industrial economics and health policy applied to medical genomics & stem cell banking. Its most recent research focuses on value-based healthcare, the development of PROM instruments, and their impact on medical team behavior and culture. Through the special ties forged between partner companies, professors and students, the Chair brings together high-level academic and professional communities spanning the entire healthcare sector.

Conference

The Chair organizes a conference series on value-based healthcare at the French Economic, Social & Environmental Council, in partnership with the International Consortium for Health Outcomes Measurement (ICHOM). The conference is attended by 300 participants and leading experts from around the world: patient advocacy groups, providers, insurers, health authorities and life science companies. The Chair invites health system leaders to share their experience in how value-based healthcare is transforming practices and informing payment models and policy reforms.
